About the Piyut

This Piyut is the only Shabbat text that originates from the Chasidut tradition. It is sung in several Chasidut traditions on the eve of Shabbat. The text carries with it an air of longing rooted in the Kabbalah. The Shabbat itself is described here as the partner of the people of Israel, becoming unified with G-d in His Torah and name. In the text the guardian of the Shabbat attempts to obtain a blessing of compassion from the Shabbat and from G-d.
